2020 HOA MEETING

Roberts Rules- Meeting opened July 18th, 2020

- -2019 minutes were approved with no changes
- -Jesse Burchett and Mike Wilke were reelected for their positions

DUES

- -34,000.00 has been collected from past dues
- 3 properties are in foreclosure and 1 was deeded to BMF
- 2 owners can't be located to contact/ no arrangement currently for 5 owners
- -60% of the dues have been collected for 2020/ Late notices will be sent at the end of August
- -Email was sent asking for 600.00 in dues for each lot. This was corrected to 300.00 and sent in an email

BUDGET

- -Current budget is 122,700.00
- -A check was just mailed for 17,000.00 to pay for sealant on the main roads
- -Legal fees have gone up to try to collect dues from owners
- -Ongoing fees are for the Insurance, grounds, phone for the gate, mailings, road maintenance
- -Ongoing fees are about 25,000.00 a year/ 36,000.00 is collected annually

PROPOSED PROJECTS

- -Community Center- gaps need filled, pressure washed and stained. Door has been replaced and crawlspace door has been fixed. Septic tank, water, kitchen and bath are options in the future
- -Culverts are being replaced on property as needed

- Looking at possibly securing a 300,000.00 loan at 1% to get water to the property
- Due to the Appalachian Wildlife Center, a water tower will be built on mountain drive. BMF will be able to feed off this water tower, but needs to come up with 300,000.00 by Spring of 2021
- -Currently, if your property backs to HWY 217, you can get water

PROJECTS COMPLETED IN 2020

- -Washout happened early in the year on the roads- culverts were put down along with 84 tons of gravel
- -Community building was pressure washed and will be stained very soon
- -Gates painted/repaired. Gate repairs were 2400.00 for 2020
- -Keypad fixed
- -Sealcoat completed/ Roads are the #1 expense for BMF
- -The area by the community building was bush-hogged
- -Working on automating the back gate/cost around 9,000.00

ERC

- -Acquired all the community areas back from ERC
- -ERC is paying 4000.00 a year in dues for 5 years

OUESTIONS FROM HOMEOWNERS

- -Any plans for more paving? Yes, on flat areas. Higher areas need gravel.
- -Any plans for internet n the area? This won't happen until addresses are changed
- -Do we need to hire someone to put in water lines?
- -Where will the water tank be? On mountain drive across from BMF
- -Is it profitable to foreclose on properties? Yes. People have paid of or paid down their mortgages

- -If someone isn't paying dues, do you have liens on those properties? Yes
- -Any availability for natural gas lines? No. Developer owns the rights and natural gas wells
